

BY-LAW No. 5A

A BY-LAW TO REPEAL BY-LAW 5, POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE CAO
SUNBURY-YORK SOUTH RURAL COMMUNITY

1. AUTHORITY:

- 1.1. Pursuant to the authority granted by Section 81 of the Local Governance Act, the Council of Sunbury-York South Rural Community enacts this by-law to repeal By-Law 5, A By-Law To Establish and Define The Duties And Powers Of The Chief Administrative Officer Of Sunbury-York South Rural Community.
- 1.2. This by-law may be cited as the Repeal of the CAO By-Law.

2. PURPOSE:


- 2.1. The Council of Sunbury-York South Rural Community now does not wish to proceed with a Chief Administrative Officer form of leadership for the local government.

3. REPEAL AND EFFECTIVE DATE:

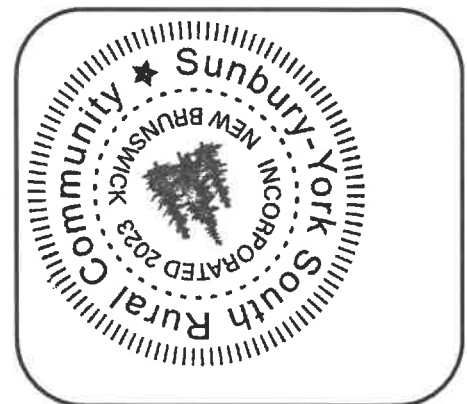
- 3.1. This by-law repeals the following by-law:
